

Education Profile – Fray Lazaro

Children in the community of Fray Lazaro can attend kindergarten-sixth grade in Escuela José Trinidad Cabañas, which is located in the center of the community. At the moment, there are 79 students enrolled in the school. While there are four classrooms, there are only three teachers at the moment. Thus, each classroom is multi-level with one teacher teaching several different curriculums and grade levels simultaneously.

As Escuela José Trinidad Cabañas is a primary school, all children wishing to continue onto seventh grade must attend secondary school several kilometers away. Only about 10% of children do so due to the cost of supplies and transportation. The majority of children also need to work to help support their families following the completion of sixth grade.

Escuela José Trinidad Cabañas has four classrooms, although only three are currently in-use. There is limited space outside for activities.

The School Schedule

The academic year begins in February and ends in November in Honduras. Classes are held from Monday to Friday beginning at 8:00 AM. At 11:30 AM, the students go home for lunch and return to school at 1:00 PM. Classes end at 3:15. In addition to the lunch, there is a snack in the morning valued at 10 Lempiras (US \$0.50 per family).
